

PRIVACY POLICY

In compliance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council, of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, Organic Law 3/2018, of 5 December, on the Protection of Personal Data and Guarantee of Digital Rights, as well as any applicable data protection provisions, we provide you with detailed information on the processing of your personal data below:

1. Who is the Data Controller of your personal data?

2. For what purpose do we process your personal data?

In compliance with applicable data protection regulations, we inform you that at Colonial we process the personal data you provide to us when completing the website registration forms for the purposes indicated below:

i. Web registration

Data collected	Name, surname, email, telephone and company.
Purpose	To enable user access keys to access the customer area.

ii. Sending commercial communications

Data collected	Name, surname, email, telephone and company.
Purpose	Within the framework of its marketing activity, Colonial may provide you with resources for registration or subscription to news or commercial information related to it. The sending of such resources will always be subject to your express consent. You may revoke your consent to receive commercial communications at any time by contacting dpo@inmocolonial.com .

iii. Contact details

Data collected	Name, surname, email and comments.
Purpose	To respond to requests for information that the user has made through the contact channels.

3. How long will we keep your personal data?

Colonial undertakes to process your personal data only as long as they are really useful and necessary to be able to offer you a quality service via their processing. Therefore, Colonial will make all appropriate and reasonable efforts to minimise the processing and retention time of your personal data.

In particular, we inform you that your personal data will be stored using the technical and organisational measures necessary to guarantee the security and integrity of the data for the following periods and, in any case, as long as you do not request its deletion:

PURPOSE	PERIOD OF RETENTION
Registration on the website (section 2.i)	Until you revoke your consent to the processing.
Sending of commercial communications (section 2.ii)	Until you revoke your consent to the processing.
Contact (section 2.iii)	As long as they are necessary to meet the request you have made to us.

In any case, and even if you request the deletion of your personal data, Colonial will have the right to keep and store it, under due protection, for the period necessary to comply with the corresponding legal obligations, as well as to make it available to the competent authorities in the different matters that may apply.

4. What is the legal basis for the processing of your personal data?

The legal basis for the purposes of the processing indicated in section 2 of this policy is the consent given by you.

5. To which recipients will your personal data be communicated?

Your personal data will not be communicated to third parties except to suppliers whose intervention is necessary for the correct management of the page. Colonial may also communicate your personal data to public bodies and authorities (administrative or judicial) in those cases where legislation so establishes.

6. What are your rights when you provide us with your personal data and how can you exercise them?

At any time, you have the right to access your personal data, as well as to request rectification of inaccurate data or, where appropriate, request its deletion when, among other reasons, the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.

Under certain circumstances, you may request the limitation of the processing of your data, in which case we will only retain it for the exercise or defence of claims.

In certain circumstances and for reasons related to your particular situation, you may object to the processing of your data. Colonial will no longer process the data, except for compelling legitimate reasons, or the exercise or defence of possible claims.

Likewise, you may exercise the right to data portability, as well as withdraw the consents provided at any time, without affecting the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent prior to its withdrawal.

If you wish to exercise any of your rights, you can contact us by sending a communication, attaching a document proving your identity and expressly indicating the right you wish to exercise, to Colonial's data protection officer at the address indicated above or by sending an email to dpo@inmocolonial.com. Lastly, we inform you that you can contact the Spanish Data Protection Agency and other competent public bodies for any claim derived from the processing of your personal data.
